

A few years ago, we were heading down to the west country for a week's holiday and stopped off at a National Trust house that served good coffee, had some short walks to stretch our legs and a 'Maize Maze' that we thought our children would enjoy. They had fun exploring the maze until they began to feel lost and didn't know which way to go. At that point they shouted out for some help, and we guided them to the centre of the maze and then out again.

There are many people who feel lost, wondering what the purpose of life is, what their place is in the world, wondering whether there is a God, and if there is, do they care? There are others who are desperate not to engage in big questions. There is a sense that the world has lost its way, as nation rises up against nation, as the geopolitical tectonic plates shift again. 
